Important Information about the High School Youth Track

- <u>Youth Ministers</u> If you are a youth minister registering teens from your parish to attend the LIAG H.S. Youth Track
 - We will need a permission form completed for each youth and adult chaperone.

- <u>LIAG Attending Parent</u> If you are a parent who intends to attend the LIAG Adult Conference and would like your teen to attend the LIAG H.S. Youth Track.
