## WORKSHOPS

- Moses Generation vs. Joshua Generation It is not only businesses that can suffer from generational disharmony. When the generation gap comes to church, it can wreak havoc with a congregational well-being and long-term sustainability. Many congregations have members from several generations, but often one generation dominates either in leadership or in numbers. This session will provide useful solutions to bridge generation gaps by teaching how to value the contributions each generation offers and what each can learn from the other.
- No Strings Attached There is a right way to date! What is it? And there are right and wrong people to date. How can you know the difference? It is time to unlearn the wrong principles, acquired from society and to learn and apply God's true principles. Through presenting God's perspective this session, we will discuss those principles.
- Club vs. Christ "It's just music!" "But...I like to dance." "I'm not getting drunk." If you have heard these responses or said them when talking about the club, this class is for you. Students will examine the current cultural/sociological trends and analyze whether or not they conflict with Jesus Christ and His message.
- C.R.E.A.M. (Cash Rules Everything Around Me) In a society surrounded by materialism, loans, and a challenging economy, investment tools and budgeting competency are essential. This session will offer helpful tools in maintaining a healthy budget and provide possible options for sound investments.
- Saved, Single, and Satisfied Does the phrase "single, saved, and satisfied" sound like an oxymoron to you? Being single doesn't have to mean feeling unfulfilled or lonely. This session strives to provide tools to view being single as a blessing and not a curse. You finally can be happy with yourself, so that true love will find you instead of you going to find it!
- Keeping the Marriage Fresh (For Married Couples) Marriages actually take more effort than other relationships. In order to keep your marriage fresh, you need to constantly work at it. This is true whether you have been married for six months or sixty years. This session will address that everyone's marriage is different, but there are a few universal things that you can do to put the spark back into a dim marriage or to ensure that your flame keeps burning as brightly as ever.
