  - A professional biography of no more than 200 words that outlines your education, applicable experience, and related certifications or licensure.
  - Proposals must be submitted in PDF format through Easy Chair via the following link: https://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=glrc2013
  - All proposals must be submitted by August 1, 2013.
- Evaluation Criteria:
  - Relevance to the conference theme and current Systems Engineering state of the art
  - Originality and importance to the region
  - Clarity and quality of thought and materials
  - Educational value--should not be sales presentations for products or services
- There are no limits on the number of proposals that any individual or organization may submit. Submitters are responsible to obtain required business, legal, or regulatory disclosure approvals pertaining to conferences open to academia and industry. All presentations must be unclassified and releasable to the public.
- Submission implies the intent of at least one author to register for the conference and present in person. Register at www.glrc2013.eventbrite.com after July 1.
