TOUR ITINERARY



Sep 25 – USA - Sao Paulo, Brazil

Today fly to one of the largest cities on the planet – Sao Paulo with more than 16 million people and the biggest financial and business center of the country. Overnight and dinner served onboard flight.

Sep 26 - Sao Paulo

Early morning arrival in Sao Paulo arrival transfer to hotel. Receive a brief orientation and a welcoming drink at the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. This evening, dine with your group and indulge in a typical "Churrascaria", a true Brazilian feast of marinated and barbecued meats. Overnight at hotel in Rio.(D)

Sep 27 - Sao Paulo

After breakfast at the hotel, spend the morning sightseeing Sao Paulo. Tour residential districts, World Cup stadiums, Governor's Palace, University Campus, Ibirapuera Park, a special visit to Butantan Institute, internationally renowned for its venomous research. You will appreciate a "Snake milking" demonstration and then drive through old and modern downtown and the oriental district known as Japantown. Sao Paulo has the largest concentration of Japanese living outside of Japan with more than 1 million people. Rest of the day at leisure and dinner on your own in the city. Overnight at hotel in Sao Paulo. (B)

Sep 28 - Sao Paulo - Rio de Janeiro

Morning is at leisure to explore other sites, museums and shopping. You also have the option to attend pre-arranged business meetings with local companies. Late afternoon transfer to airport to take flight to Rio de Janeiro. On arrival in Rio, transfer to hotel. (B)

Sep 29 - Rio de Janeiro

Today, experience the unforgettable views of Rio from the magnificent structure known as Christ the Redeemer. Ascend by train to the top of Corcovado and take in panoramic views of the breathtaking city of Rio.

You will also pass by Maracana Stadium, the largest stadium in the world, and the enchanting Botanical Gardens. Then, take a cable car to the top of Sugarloaf to observe the natural beauty of the beaches and rolling forests. Lunch is included. Overnight at hotel in Rio. (B/L)

Sep 30 - Rio de Janeiro

All day is at your leisure to explore local markets, rest at the Beach or take optional tours. The hotel is opposite to famous Copacabana Beach and nearby restaurants, bars and shops. At night, meet your group and prepare to experience the energy of Carnival with traditional dancers, exotic costumes, and the glamor and rhythm of a colorful samba show. Overnight at hotel in Rio.(B)

Oct 01 - Rio de Janeiro

This morning, venture into a Rio de Janeiro favela on a half-day educational tour. See the day-to-day lifestyles of locals who live in Santa Marta, one of Rio's many dense favelas. With a local expert guide, travel inside the favela, interact with locals and gain a new understanding of Brazilian society. Rest of the day at your leisure. Overnight at hotel in Rio.(B)

Oct 02 - Rio de Janeiro

Take a morning tour from Rio to the Tijuca Rain Forest, in an open jeep. The four-hour jeep tour includes an easy hike, giving you the chance to spot monkeys, birds, butterflies and tropical flora and take spectacular photos. You'll be amazed by the remarkable contrast of a tropical rain forest right in the middle of a big city. Rest of the day at your leisure. Overnight at hotel in Rio.(B)

Oct 03 - Rio de Janeiro - USA

Following breakfast at the hotel, you'll transfer to Rio airport for return flight to the USA. (B)
