Why:

Issue:

- 40% 60% of the workforce will retire in the next 5-10 years
- Average age in exploration & production companies is 50 years old; among the oldest of any industry
- Since 1981 the Energy Industry has lost 1.1 million employees

Minority students view on the Energy Industry:

- Cyclical nature of industry: job insecurity, unpredictable & history of lay-offs
- Tough working conditions
- Industry is thought of as low-tech
- Negative perceptions about environmental impact of industry
- Industry suffers an image problem
