## Directions to The Meadows Office Building Updated 4-19-2013

The Otsego County Department of Planning and Solid Waste is located in The Meadows Office Building, located on County Route 33W, about 5 miles south of Cooperstown. The Meadows Office Building is the county's former nursing home. The building is located about one mile east of NYS Route 28 near the hamlet of Hyde Park.

<u>Directions</u>: *From Cooperstown:* Take County Route 52 East out of Cooperstown to intersection of 33 and 52. Head south on Rt. 33 approximately 5 miles passed the intersection of 11C. to Co. Rt. 33W. Turn right onto Rt. 33W. The building is on the right. You should park in the main parking lot just beyond the building.

For daytime meetings, come into the building through the main front entrance and get directions to the Planning/Solid Waste Department from one of the security guards. Or, if it has been prearranged, you may come directly to our meeting room by entering the building as described in the following two sentences. For nighttime meetings, come into the building through one of two side doors on the back wing of the building and near the parking lot. The left door will immediately bring you into Classroom B; the right door will bring you into Classroom A.

<u>Directions:</u> From Oneonta: Take NYS Route 28 from Oneonta heading to Cooperstown. Turn right at the traffic light in the Village of Milford onto Co. highway 166. Follow 166 to the intersection of Rt. 166 and 33. Turn left onto 33. You will pass Brewery Ommegang on your right before reaching intersection of 33 and 33W. Turn left onto 33W. Building is on your right. Park in the main parking lot just beyond the building
